WHEREAS, consistent with the Order of the Illinois Supreme Court in M.R. 30370, dated March 17, 2020, which was adopted in response to the COVID-19 outbreak and the emergencies declared by the State and Federal governments;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, the Clerk of the Circuit Court shall accept, for the duration of General Order 20-07, criminal bond call paperwork by email at crimclerk1@co.kane.il.us.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, bond call will be heard via video conferencing. The presence of the Kane County State's Attorney and the Kane County Public Defender's Office is required at each of the hearings. These hearings will take place Monday thru Friday at 8:30 a.m. and 1:30 p.m., and at 8:30 a.m. on the weekends. This will be for newly filed charges, new charges seeking an arrest warrant and for any served arrest warrants. After hearing has commenced the Circuit Clerk's Office will email back to the Police agency the copies of the Orders signed by the Judge. The arresting agency shall mail or drop off original paperwork within 48 hours.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that these changes are only temporary and that after the COVID-19 crisis is diverted, Bond Call will resume original practice.
