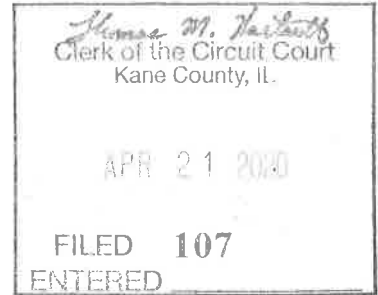


IN THE SIXTEENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT
GENERAL ORDER 20-15
effective April 21, 2020



IN THE MATTER OF)
TEMPORARILY AMENDING)
SENTENCE CONCLUSION DATES AND)
PAYMENT OBLIGATIONS FOR CERTAIN)
TRAFFIC CASES)

WHEREAS in light of the Coronavirus pandemic, and in order to protect the health and safety of the general public and pursuant to Illinois Supreme Court, this Court's inherent authority;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that with regard to all state and local traffic-related matters (*including* for purposes of this Order: Driving While License Suspended, Driving While License Revoked or Driving Under the Influence misdemeanors) where: (1) the term of supervision or conditional discharge was set to expire between **March 17, 2020 and June 8, 2020**, (2) the case is currently paid in full, (3) regardless of whether or not the ordered traffic school was completed, and (4) regardless of whether ordered Community Restitution Service (CRS) is completed, it is hereby ordered, that the matter is discharged satisfactorily and no further court appearance will be required. Clerk to send notice to the defendant.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that with regard to all state and local traffic-related matters (*including* for purposes of this Order: Driving While License Suspended, Driving While License Revoked or Driving Under the Influence misdemeanors) where: (1) the term of supervision or conditional discharge was set to expire between **March 17, 2020 and June 8, 2020**, (2) the case is NOT paid in full by the term date, (3) regardless of whether or not the ordered traffic school was completed, and (4) regardless of whether ordered CRS is completed, it is hereby ordered, the clerk is to send notice to the defendant that if the matter is paid in full before June 8, 2020 or, if not, then within 120 days of this Order, the matter will be deemed discharged satisfactorily and no further court appearance will be required. If, thereafter, payment is not made by the aforementioned 120th day, clerk to send an initial Failure to Pay notice to defendant.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that with regard to all state and local traffic-related matters (*including* for purposes of this Order Driving While License Suspended, Driving While License Revoked or Driving Under the Influence misdemeanors) where: (1) the term of supervision or conditional discharge is set to expire between **May 4, 2020 and August 31, 2020**, (2) the case is currently paid in full, (3) regardless of whether or not the ordered traffic school was completed, and (4) regardless of whether ordered CRS is completed, it is hereby ordered, that the matter will be deemed discharged satisfactorily and no further court appearance will be required. If, thereafter, payment is not made by the aforementioned 120th day, clerk to send an initial Failure to Pay notice to defendant.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that with regard to all state and local traffic matters (*including* for purposes of this Order: Driving While License Suspended, Driving While License Revoked and Driving Under the Influence misdemeanors) where: (1) the term of supervision or conditional discharge was set to expire between **May 4, 2020 and August 31, 2020**, (2) the case is NOT paid in full by the term date, (3) regardless of whether or not the ordered traffic school was completed, and (4) regardless of whether ordered CRS is completed, it is hereby ordered, the clerk is to send notice to the defendant that if the matter is paid in full before August 31, 2020 or, if not, then within 120 days of the defendant's term date then the matter will be deemed discharged satisfactorily and the clerk is to send notice to the defendant that no further court appearance is required. If payment is not made by the aforementioned 120th day, clerk to send an initial Failure to Pay notice to defendant.

IT IS THEREFORE FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk shall notify all contracted Driver's Safety Class providers that all obligations to complete traffic school ordered before the effective date of this Order shall be deemed satisfied until further Order of the Court.
